

HomeLink Training for Two-Way Compatible Devices

1. For first time training, press and hold the two outer HomeLink buttons, releasing only when the HomeLink indicator light begins to flash after 10 seconds.
 - Do not perform this step when training the additional HomeLink buttons.
2. Press and release the HomeLink button you would like to train, and an indicator light will begin slowly flashing.
3. Position the hand-held garage door or gate remote 1-3 inches away from the HomeLink buttons in your mirror.
4. Press and hold the button on your hand-held garage door or gate remote. **Do not release** until the HomeLink indicator light changes from slowly flashing to rapidly flashing.
5. **Wait until your garage door or gate has stopped moving** before completing the next steps.
6. Press and hold the trained HomeLink button for 2 seconds, then release. Wait 3 seconds, then repeat the press/hold/release process again.
 - If the indicator light blinks rapidly, and the door is not moving, proceed with the following training instructions.
 1. A second person may make the following steps quicker and easier.
 2. A ladder may be needed to reach the “Learn,” “Program,” or “Smart” button on your garage door opener or gate opener. Do not stand on your vehicle to perform the next steps.
7. On your garage door opener in your garage, or on the motor for your gate, locate the “Learn” “Program,” or “Smart” button. The name and color of the button will vary by manufacturer, but this button is usually located near where the hanging antenna wire is attached to the garage door or gate opener. If there is difficulty locating this button, reference the device’s owner’s manual.
8. **Please note: this step is time sensitive.** Press and release the “Learn,” “Program,” or “Smart” button. Please note: Once the button is pressed, you will have up to 30 seconds in which to initiate the next step.
9. Return to the vehicle and firmly press and hold the trained HomeLink button for two seconds and release. Wait three seconds, then repeat the “press/hold/release” sequence to complete the training process.

Manual Two-Way Communication Enrollment

If your garage door opener or gate has two-way functionality, but the arrow indicators in your HomeLink do not appear after completing training, complete the following steps:

1. In your vehicle, press and hold the trained HomeLink button for 2 seconds, then release. Confirm that the garage door or gate is moving. When it stops, you will have one minute to complete the following steps:
 - A second person may make the following steps quicker and easier.
 - A ladder may be needed to reach the “Learn,” “Program,” or “Smart” button on your garage door opener or gate opener. Do not stand on your vehicle to perform the next steps.
2. On your garage door opener in your garage, or on the motor for your gate, locate the “Learn” “Program,” or “Smart” button (usually near where the hanging antenna wire is attached to the garage door or gate opener). If there is difficulty locating this button, reference the device’s owner’s manual.
3. Press and release the “Learn,” “Program,” or “Smart” button.
4. A light on your garage door or gate opener will flash, and your two-way HomeLink indicators in your vehicle may flash as well, confirming completion of the process.
5. Pressing the trained HomeLink button will now activate your garage door or gate and show when the device is moving and has finished moving.
6. Your two-way enrollment is now complete.
